### City's King Commission awards grants

The city of Bloomington's Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission has awarded \$21,000 in grant funds to local organizations for "A Day On! Not A Day Off" volunteer service projects on the Jan. 19 King holiday.

"Martin Luther King Jr, Day presents an excellent opportunity for us to enhance community condition and collaborations," Bloomington Mayor Mark Kruzan said in a prepared statement. "We are pleased to announce that this year we are awarding the largest amount of funding since we began 'A Day On! Not A Day Off' in 1998."

Kruzan said the Community Foundation of Bloomington and Monroe County and Service for Peace provided the city with the grant funds, which are directed to local groups to help them acquire materials and supplies needed for volunteer service projects.
