City announces \$17,100 in Martin Luther King Day grants

The city's Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Commission awarded \$17,100 in grants to 53 local groups for service projects to honor King.

"A Day On, Not a Day Off," which falls on Jan. 21 next year, started in 1998. This is the largest amount of funding the city has awarded, according to a news release.

The Community Foundation of Bloomington and Monroe County and Points of Light and Hands on Network provided \$12,000 and \$5,000 grants, respectively.
