

## Medical Services

Volunteers in Medicine provides free, high quality primary and preventive care for both chronic and acute illnesses, as well as:

- Medications\*
- Dental care
- Psychological counseling
- Specialists
- ◆ Diagnostic laboratory and radiology tests
- ◆ Referrals for eye care

\* NOTE: It is VIM policy to prescribe narcotics ONLY for very short-term pain.

## Eligibility

The Volunteers in Medicine clinic serves individuals who:

- reside in Monroe or Owen counties
- live in households with income at or below 200% of the federal poverty level
- do not have health insurance, **OR**
- cannot afford any insurance option, **OR**
- have Healthy IN Plan insurance, but need additional services, such as dental



## Health Support Services

Becoming HEALTHY is complicated! Going to a doctor for the diagnosis and treatment of an illness or medical condition is only part of the picture.

Other factors that affect a person's health and wellness have to do with health behaviors, what we call "lifestyle" choices. This includes tobacco use, diet, nutrition, physical activity, alcohol and drug use, and so forth.

For the many people without insurance, VIM continues to provide the free medical, dental, mental health, specialty care, and medications for which we are well known.

For individuals with insurance that meet VIM eligibility criteria, VIM health support services enhance the care provided by your doctor, with health education, care management, medication support, and coordination of services.

### ***IU Health Bloomington Hospital***

Since the clinic's inception, IUHB has provided millions of dollars of medical support for VIM patients. The hospital continues its generosity by donating 2.5 employees to the VIM clinic.

### ***Medical and Lay Volunteers***

Hundreds of local medical and lay volunteers donate their time and expertise to help the staff.

Volunteer roles include:

- physicians, dentists and pharmacists
- nurse practitioners and nurses
- counselors, psychologists, psychiatrists
- receptionists and appointment schedulers
- data entry and medical records
