### Specialists volunteer for clinic

More than 160 medical specialists have agreed to volunteer their time to treat patients at the new Volunteers in Medicine free medical clinic scheduled to open Monday in Bloomington.

The 162 specialty physicians who've volunteered practice in such areas as orthopedic surgery, ophthalmology, urology and general surgery.

They will see patients in their offices and clinics when they need to be seen for further consultation, diagnosis and treatment.

Seeing patients at the VIM clinic will be primary care physicians, internists, nurse practitioners, mental health providers, social workers, some dentists, and lay volunteers.

The specialists and most dentists will be working off-site in their offices and clinics.

"Without the support of all these providers, we wouldn't be able to fulfill our mission," said Dr. Eric Bannec, the clinic's medical director, in a prepared statement.

That support includes radiologists from Southern Indiana Radiology Associates who will read X-rays and other imaging scans, pathologists who will process and analyze blood work and other lab tests, anesthesiologists who will assist in surgeries, and the Indiana University School of Optometry and local optometrists who will provide free eye exams and low-cost glasses.

"With the response we've received from our community, we'll be able to provide a spectrum of care for our patients," said Bannec. "This will include everything from primary care and prevention in the form of wellness and health education to consultations with specialists; and diagnostic testing and hospitalization at Bloomington Hospital when necessary."

The clinic, at 333 E. Miller Drive in the space that housed Bloomington Hospital's Community Health Access Program clinic, also will be fueled by 300 lay volunteers who will assist the medical professionals.
