## 100+ Women Who Care donates to Volunteers in Medicine

Local group 100+ Women Who Care, an organization of women who make quarterly donations to not-for-profit organizations in Monroe County, has announced its 19th donation of nearly \$18,000.

The donation, made up of \$100 from each of about 180 women, was awarded to Volunteers in Medicine Clinic of Monroe County, a United Way partner agency, to support its newly expanded dental clinic.

Specifically, funds from this donation will help VIM purchase dental supplies, upgrade equipment and fund patient referrals for dentures. "Already, with 100+ Women funding, the VIM dentists have ordered the supplies needed to begin doing root canals and crowns. We are thrilled to offer the community more hours and expanded dental services, as VIM continues to be the only source of

free dental care in the community,” says Nancy Richman, VIM executive director. The expanded VIM dental clinic offers both preventive and restorative dental care, including assessment, cleanings, procedures, and education to help patients take responsibility for and sustain their health over time.

The presentation was made at the Volunteers in Medicine clinic to Richman. Present for the celebration were 100+ Women Who Care members and clinic employees.

Since November 2011, 100+ Women Who Care has donated over \$475,000 to local nonprofits.
